HOW TO SUBMIT

1. Sign the Marital Settlement Agreement in front of a notary — both of you.
2. Upload the packet through JEDS at njcourts.gov/self-help/jeds and pay the \$300 filing fee (\$325 with children).
3. Include self-addressed stamped envelopes so the signed judgment comes back by mail.
4. Two to four months is typical. A judge can still ask for a short hearing.
